# INDIANAPOLIS MOTOR SPEEDWAY SUITE REMODEL

In early April of last year we started demolition on two Tower Terrace suites at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway. We had a little over 30 days allowed for construction to get the suites ready for the race season. The first race was May 12th, and all work had to be completed by May 9th. We removed nine foot tall, four foot wide floor-to-ceiling mirrors from one of the walls. They must have originally been lifted to the suite with a crane, as they would not fit in the elevator. We had to cut them into smaller pieces on-site and take them down the service elevator to get them down to the dumpster. We removed wallpaper, which was not sized, so it took out chunks of drywall every few inches. We touched up the drywall, and painted the walls. We replaced the old vinyl flooring and

carpet with new carpet tiles. The original carpet tiles would not release without a fight. It ended up taking multiple applications of glue softeners and a professional motorized floor scraper to get the carpet removed. We added buffet cabinets & countertops, and painted the existing cabinets, trim, and ceilings. We also upgraded the cabinet hardware. As Opening Day grew closer we could hear the cars running around the track for testing. One of the last things we did was install a rolling garage door to separate the two suites. This would allow the suites to be separate smaller areas, but would also allow them the flexibility to be one larger space if required. By the time we were finished the suites had a completely new refreshed look. We completed the work on time, and the clients were happy.
